



NOTICE OF NOMINATION AND ELECTION PROCEDURE 2011

A. Nominations for Election of British Columbia Members to Council

Under the By-Laws of the British Columbia Branch of the Canadian Bar Association, each County in the Province shall be represented on Council. This year there are **eighteen (18)** members to be elected for **three (3)** year terms; **one (1)** member to be elected for a **two (2)** year term; and **one(1)** member to be elected for a **one (1)** year term. Shorter terms will be filled by the candidate with the highest number of votes after three-year term positions are filled. **Only CBA members are eligible for nomination and election and if elected, must maintain CBA membership throughout their term of office.**

Those eligible to **nominate** and **vote** for a county representative are **CBA members** who are:

- a) *Practicing* members whose principal place of *business* is in the County, and
- b) *Non-practicing* members whose *residence* is situated in the County.

County representation and the number of Council members to be elected this year is as follows:
