Law School Essay Contest in Environmental, Energy and Resources Law

- David Estrin Prize -

1. Essays submitted for consideration should address an issue in environmental, energy or resources law that is original, significant and relevant to Canada.
2. Authors must be registered and attend the law faculty of a Canadian University as of February 29, 2012.
3. Essays must be submitted by email, **in Word or Word Perfect format only**, or by mail to: Corinna Robitaille (National Sections Liaison Officer, Canadian Bar Association, Suite 500-865 Carling Avenue, Ottawa, Ontario, K1S 5S8; corinnar@cba.org) with "NEERLS' Law School Essay Contest" in the Subject Line. Essays must have been received by the CBA no later than **February 29, 2012**.

Submission of an essay implies that it comprises the author's own original unpublished work. Papers that are submitted for a law school course are eligible. The author must retain a copy of his or her electronic file containing the essay submitted.

4. Essays should not exceed 12,000 words, including footnotes and endnotes.
5. Authors should supply a mailing address, phone number, short biography and the name of the law school they are attending. Authors must ensure their name and school appear **only** on the title page.
6. Essays must be written in English or French and should be typewritten, double-spaced with wide margins. All pages should be numbered consecutively. Title and headings should be concise.
7. Essays submitted for consideration must be researched and written by one author.
8. Notes may be footnotes or endnotes. They should be numbered consecutively throughout the text with superscript Arabic numbers.
9. Each author should sign, date and return an original Assignment of Copyright form to Corinna Robitaille, National Sections Liaison Officer, The Canadian Bar Association, Suite 500-865 Carling Avenue, Ottawa, Ontario, K1S 5S8, prior to the date indicated in section 3.
