- Format: Live online presentation with video, audio and PowerPoint slides.
- **Delivery:** Speakers present from their own offices (via Zoom Webinar using internet) from 12:00 to 1:30pm Eastern Time.
- Accreditation: Webinars are usually accredited for 90 minutes of CPD credits in all Canadian jurisdictions.
- Audience: Lawyers across Canada from diverse practice areas and with various levels of experience.
- Interactivity: The platform allows for polling of the audience and Q&A.
- **Marketing:** Webinars are promoted as part of the CBA Law Series via email blasts and on the CBA website and social media.
- **Speaker invitations:** Once the proposal and speakers list has been approved, Sections can formally invite speakers.
- **Deadline for proposal:** Complete the proposal form on page 2 and submit it to <u>cba.sections@cba.org</u> by October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023.
- **Timeline:** The CBA encourages topic and speaker suggestions from Sections. Upon approval of top ics, PD staff assume responsibility for speaker coordination, webinar logistics, accreditation, promotion and delivery.
