ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS the Canadian Bar Association has chosen the theme “Access to Justice, Justice for All” to increase public knowledge of laws and the legal system so that people are more aware of their rights and their obligations, and

WHEREAS Law Day is sponsored nationally by the Canadian Bar Association and the Federal Department of Justice; and provincially by the BC Branch of the Canadian Bar Association, the Law Society of British Columbia, Continuing Legal Education Society, Vancouver Bar Association, the Law Foundation; and the Ministry of the Attorney General, and

WHEREAS there will be public events including an open house at the Vancouver Public Library, a public speaking contest, a public forum and other events province wide, and

WHEREAS Our Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, has been pleased to enact Order in Council 903 on October 11, 2002;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that April 11 to 17, 2010, inclusive, shall be known as

“Law Week”

in the Province of British Columbia.
