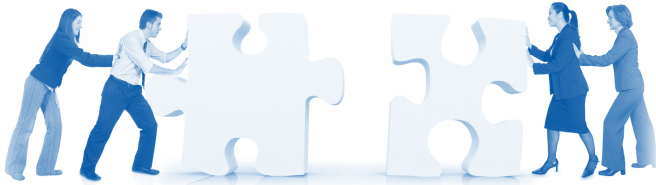

# Introduction au droit collaboratif

In this introductory course, lawyers will learn the stages of the collaborative law process and be introduced to the skills necessary to effectively act as counsel in the process. The course includes a broader context of concepts and practices related to conflict resolution generally, and will assist lawyers in:

- understanding and getting more comfortable with conflict identifying different styles of problem-solving and different approaches to conflict situations
- understanding the dynamics of conflict escalation and how to assist parties and oneself in managing and resolving conflict
- learning about the communication skills which assist in understanding others' perspectives and resolving conflict. Those skills are more specifically taught in the second level course, Interest-based Negotiation for Collaborative Lawyers
- Understanding the unique role of counsel in a collaborative law process
- Learning how to work collaboratively with "opposing" counsel.

The materials will include checklists on how to prepare for and conduct a collaborative law process. This is a very practical course which will give lawyers the chance to learn how to put this process into practice.
