

**CANADIAN BAR ASSOCIATION - NOVA SCOTIA (CBA-NS)
CONSTANCE R. GLUBE SPIRIT AWARD**

CBA-NS Women's Forum plans to honour members who are strong advocates for the principles of the CBA. Up to four nominees will be honoured and profiled and one will be selected to receive the Constance R. Glube Spirit Award. This award celebrates members who demonstrate "CBA Spirit" through outstanding effort and contribution to women in law through involvement with the Canadian Bar Association Nova Scotia Branch.

Eligibility - This recognition is open to any individual CBA member in good standing of the Nova Scotia Branch. Table Officers of the Nova Scotia Branch are not eligible for this Award. A deceased CBA member may be nominated for the Award in the year in which he or she dies, otherwise there shall be no posthumous Award.

Presentation - The recognition ceremony will take place at our Constance R. Glube Spirit Award Dinner on October 28, 2011. Candidates are responsible for their travel expenses to the presentation.

Nomination Procedure - A Formal Nomination Form must be completed and submitted by an individual accompanied by a concise curriculum vitae or biographical profile of the Nominee. The nominee or family where appropriate must be advised that his or her name has been put forward for this recognition. The

Professional Development Committee may nominate candidates directly for this recognition.

Criteria: The qualifications for this recognition may include but are not restricted to:

- Exhibits strong "CBA Spirit" demonstrated by a willingness to volunteer for and to promote the work of the CBA.
- Advocacy of the CBA in general with a focus on CBA-NS regardless of number of years of membership.
- Dedication to leadership, mentoring and/or education of women in the law through participation in CBA conferences, seminars, committees and events.
- Involvement in community work which has enhanced the profile of women in law and the profile of CBA-NS.
- Advancement of changes in the practise of law for women lawyers.

Deadline - September 30, 2011

Selection Process - The Nominations Committee will review all applications and short list up to four nominees who will be honoured and profiled at the Awards Ceremony.
